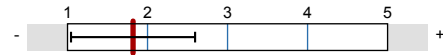

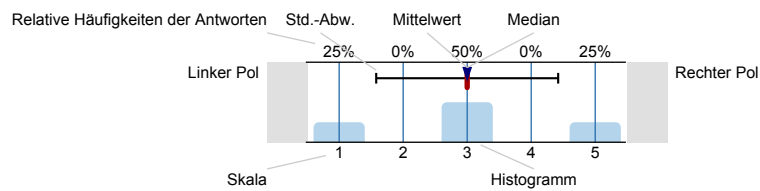

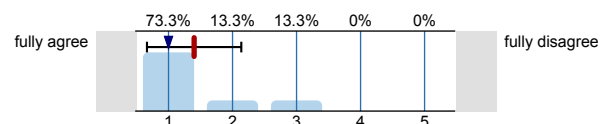

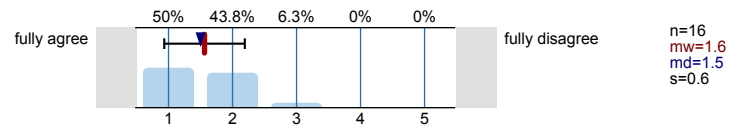


How much time per week (in hours) do you spend on this topic outside the sessions?

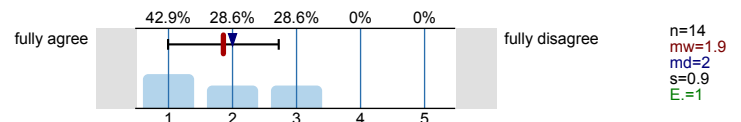

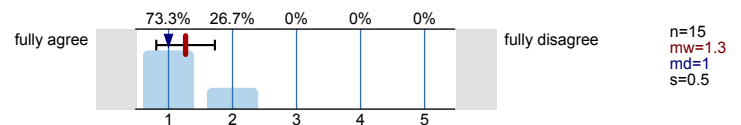
There was a good and concentrated learning environment.

The manner of speaking and behaviour between all those involved in the session was respectful.

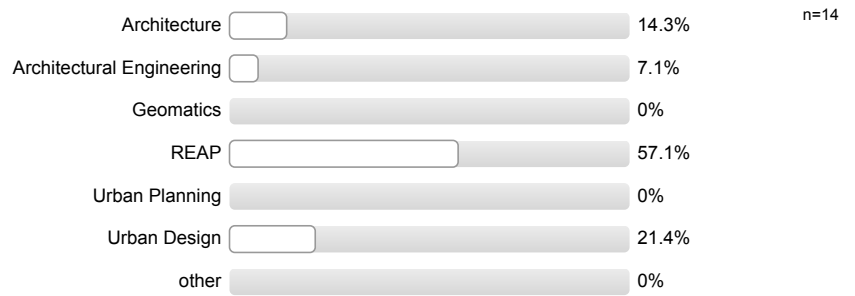
